Fourth Sunday of Advent, December 22, 2024

#### Dear Parishioners.

It's hard to believe that our season of Advent is coming to an end as we celebrate this weekend the 4th and last Sunday of Advent. In our gospel for this weekend, we hear presented the Visitation Story, where Mary sets out in haste to visit her cousin Elizabeth. And what happens next reveals so much about the mystery of Christmas. "When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, 'Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb." Yes, this woman who was filled with grace, conceived the Word of God, and this Word became flesh, taking upon Himself our human nature. And that's the Christmas mystery. In just a few days, this Christmas mystery becomes the most important good news for all humanity than we could ever imagine. For on that Christmas morning, we hear proclaimed by an angel, "for today in the city of David a Savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord." And as we anticipate these glorious words, I do want to wish each and everyone of you a very Blessed and Merry Christmas.

Our Mass schedule for Christmas is the following:

Tuesday, December 24th: Masses will be at 4:00, 6:00, and 8:00 p.m.

The 4:00 p.m. Mass is always the most popular Mass and so expect a big crowd often with standing room only. The 6:00 is usually the family Mass, a little less crowded. And the 8:00 p.m. Mass is even less crowded.

Wednesday, December 25th: Masses will be at 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.

This Sunday, December 22nd, we will be celebrating an all city wide reconciliation service here at St. Peter Church beginning at 3:00 p.m. There will be a number of priests from the area who will be here to hear individual confessions for those who would like to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation before Christmas. This will be the last opportunity to celebrate this Sacrament before Christmas. Please use this last available time to receive the graces of this sacrament and thus fulfill your Advent practice.

We will also be having Eucharistic Adoration this Sunday from 5:45 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. As the Word of God became flesh that first Christmas, we are invited to gather to worship His same Real Presence as it is adored on our altar today. This Real Presence gives us a sense of hope and so today we will be having a short reflection on that hope at 5:45 p.m. Like the shepherds, we are invited to come and worship this Real Presence of our Lord in the Eucharist this Sunday.

Just to let you know that we have hired a new full-time Director of Liturgy and Music. After several differing interviews, we selected Jesse Mose. Jesse is familiar to many as he has been a musical accompanist here at St. Peter Church for two years. He is very qualified and will be joining us on the first day of January. I ask you to welcome him and make him feel at home with us. Having a full—time director will be different but it will be rewarding to our parish.


